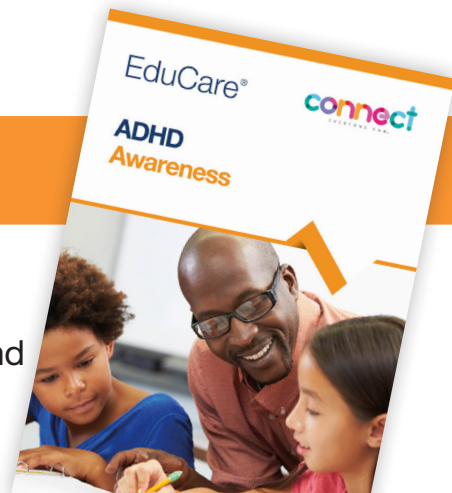


ADHD Awareness
