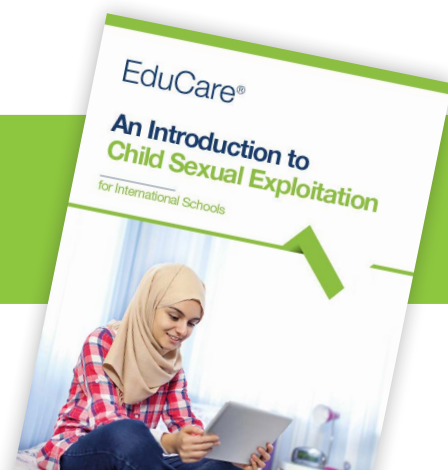


Child Sexual Exploitation for International Schools
