


## Child Exploitation

Child exploitation refers to a child or young person being used for someone else's gain. Child exploitation is a form of abuse which can involve sexual, abusive or manipulative behaviour. - what to do if you are worried about a child, plus organisations that can provide advice and guidance if you know or suspect a person is a victim of exploitation.


