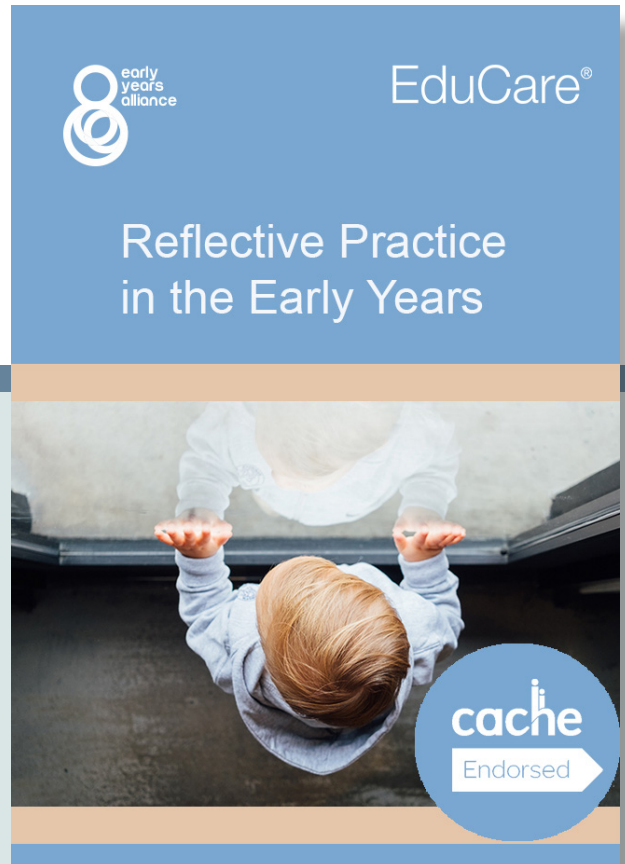


## Reflective Practice in the Early Years
