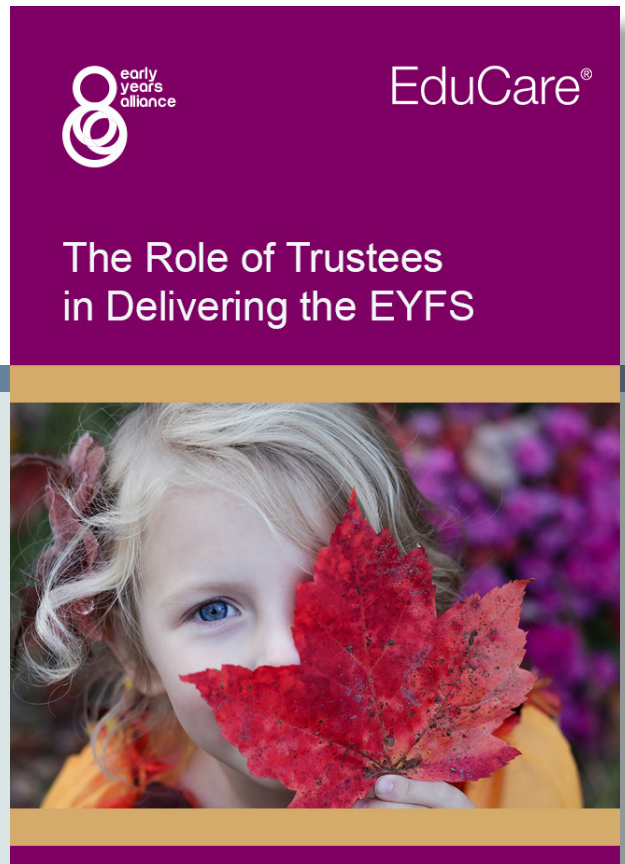


The role of Trustees in Delivering the EYFS
