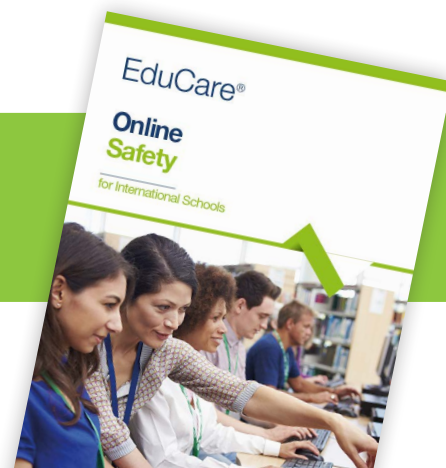


Online Safety for International Schools
