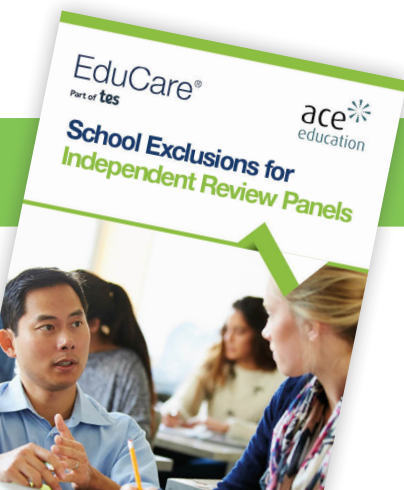


School Exclusions for IRP's
