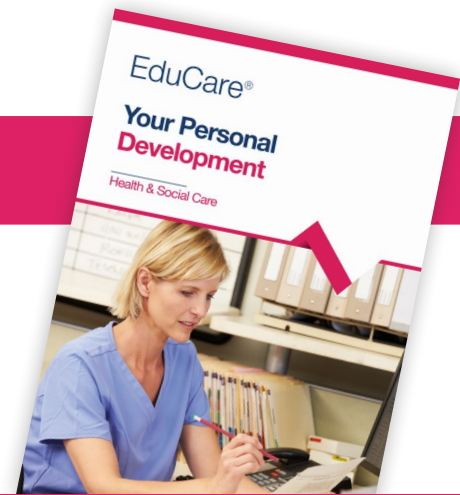


Your Personal Development
